The Institute had its 4th Graduation on the October, 20th 2018 at its Campus at Mbweni, Zanzibar.

A total of 84 students from 6 engineering disciplines, 3 ICTB, 29 Vocational Training Teachers, and 7 Mathematics and Sciences teachers for primary schools graduated, at Ordinary diploma level.

There were also 209 Vocational Training graduates from different fields, from automotive, carpentry, automobile wiring, architecture etc.

Engineering graduates

5 in Computer engineering, there were 4 First class graduates 1 female out of 4.

21 in Civil engineering, of them there were 6 First class graduates 4 female out of 6.

23 in Electrical engineering, of them there were 9 First class graduates 1 female out of 9.

12 in Electronic engineering, of them there were 5 First class graduates 2 female out of 5.

23 in Mechanical engineering, of them there were 8 First class graduates 4 female out of 8.

ICT with Business

3 graduated in Information and Communication Technology with Business, all of them were First class graduates.

Vocational Training Teachers

29 graduates in Vocational Training Teachers, of them there were 5 first class graduates 3 female out of 5.



The other events which took place in this graduation ceremony were giving Prizes to Best KIST staff from Administration, Mr Hamad Mkubwa, was chosen as the best staff from that criteria. Mr Juma Khatib was from teachers (Instructors), and Mr Issa Abdallah Mwalimu was from general staff members.
